There will be a New Exhibitors Briefing offered on Friday morning prior to judging. Check with the TVSSC Show
Committee for times and locations.

Concessions

Concessions will be available at the show site.

Building & Ring Rules

No Alcoholic Beverages are allowed to be brought into the building.

Reminder to all smokers: The City of Canton prohibits any smoking in the pavilions.

Parents are solely responsible for their children at all times. No baby strollers will be allowed in the building. No
chairs will be provided at ringside. Exhibitors and spectators may bring their own chairs. No more than one row of
chairs may be set up at ringside. Dogs will be allowed in rings during judging only.

Entries

Only dogs that are eligible and entered to be shown are allowed within the building. No dogs may be offered for
sale within the show site during designated show hours. Chapter 14, Section 11 of the American Kennel Club Rules
will be strictly enforced by the show committee.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any
service or notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judging need not wait for any do holding
up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog in the judging rings.

A recording fee of \$.50 and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or
Member Club Show. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the first
entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.) These fees are paid to the American Kennel
Club.

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U. S. accounts or with international money orders in
U. S. funds.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Remedy must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be
accepted. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned
checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a money order only basis.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or
barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external
parasites and communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire,
extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any
other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Secretary.

Upon submission of entry exhibitors release Trinity Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club, its officers and board members,
City of Canton, the Show Secretary, and their agents and affiliates from all liability for loss, damage or injury sus-
tained by exhibitors, handlers, their children, or to any of their dogs or property.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will
not be accepted without fees, signatures or the “Agreement” on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry Form.

Changes, addition, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those re-
ceived by telephone are not acceptable.

Exhibitors Note: Please notify the Secretary of any change of address.

The Trinity Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the
Official AKC entry form for this event.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

SITE AVAILABILITY

The show site will be available to exhibitors not before 8:00 am October 14, 2016 or when the Show Committee has completed preparations. Dogs and equipment must be removed from all buildings immediately following Best in Show on Sunday, October 16, 2016.

The show grounds at these shows include the show buildings, the outside grounds, and all parking areas. There will be no authorized use of perimeter buildings; access is only to Arbors I, II, and III.

Per Section 1 & 2 of AKC's dealing with misconduct, the Trinity Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club and the Tyler Texas Kennel Club reserve the right to retain Events Committee jurisdiction over exhibitors whose names have been referred by hotels/motels as having left their rooms and/or grounds in a state that appears negligent or offensive.

Any exhibitor arguing with show officials, exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior, or violating ANY club or AKC rule will be subject to Event Committee jurisdiction.

Loading & Unloading

Loading and unloading will be coordinated under the direction of the Grounds Committee.

Parking

Regular parking will be free. RV parking will be available for a fee in designated area and will be coordinated under the direction of the RV Parking Committee. Refer to the RV Parking and Campsites section of the Premium List for details. The City of Canton ordinance forbids parking of vehicles in pavilions or buildings. There will be no saving of parking spaces. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk.

The City of Canton, Arbors I, II, & III, and the show giving club will not be responsible for losses caused by fire, burglary, theft, or any other casualties whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

The Trinity Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club and the Tyler Texas Kennel Club reserves the right to rescue dogs in distress left in vehicles.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claims for damages against Trinity Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club, Tyler Texas Kennel Club, or its members in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Crating and Grooming Space

All set-ups must be in Arbors I, II, III or approved RV sports. Use of any other pavilions, buildings, or hook-ups will be considered trespassing by the City of Canton.

There will be no saving of grooming space.

Reserved Grooming Space near the rings will be available for a fee. See the Reserved Grooming Space Reservation Form in the Premium List for details. Ample free grooming space will be available in Arbor II and marked sections of Arbor I. Please be considerate of other exhibitors and use only the space marked.

Electrical cords may not be plugged into poles at ringside. Bring long extension cords and duct tape to reach other outlets which are located on the building walls. All electrical cords must be taped to the floor for safety BEFORE being plugged in. Failure to comply will result in an Events Committee hearing.

Grooming areas are setup under the supervisions of the Building & Grounds Committee who may require rearrangement of exhibitor setups where space is not properly utilized. Exhibitors may be required to stack crates and limit the number of grooming tables and other grooming equipment at the discretion of the Show Committee. Although strongly discouraged, soft-sided crates may be used for day-crating only. No dogs may be left overnight in soft-sided crates. Any dogs left overnight must have Owner's information clearly marked on each crate.

Overnight security will be provided.

The City of Canton and the show giving clubs assume no responsibility for dogs left in the pavilions overnight.

This is a SELF CLEANING show site. Exhibitors will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming setup.

Exercise Pens may be set up indoors ONLY IN PRIME RESERVED GROOMING SPACES, and if the reserved space provides adequate room. No other exercise pens will be permitted indoors. All exercise pens on concrete must have plastic under them. Any papers, shavings, etc must be cleaned daily. No shavings will be available for sale at the show site. Outside exercise pens will be allowed in designated areas. Exhibitors will be responsible for prompt removal of soiled material during show hours and complete clean-up before leaving the show site. Trash cans and dumpsters will be provided.

NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN RESTROOMS. Dumping of dog food or grooming residue in the restroom sinks and toilets is strictly prohibited. Dogs may be bathed at faucets outside of the building with water hose connections; bring your own hose. Owners must clean up the bathing area when they have finished bathing the dog.

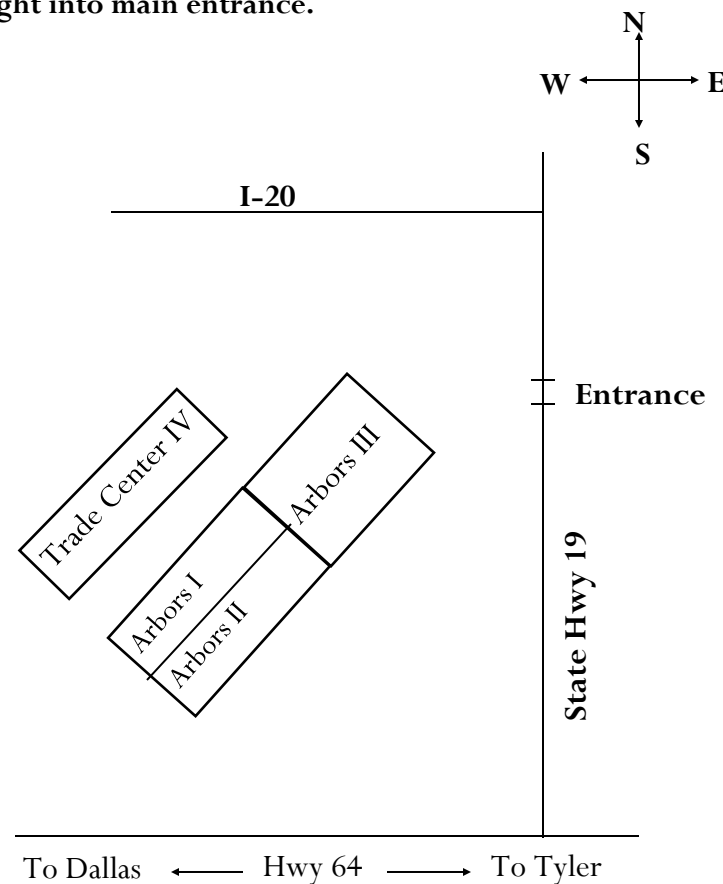
